1. **Minutes**

Motion made by VanPatten seconded by LaRocco to accept the January minutes as submitted. All in favor.

2. **Park Use Applications**

Parks and Trails NY Cycling the Erie Canal

Requests use of the Meadows area of Collins Park on the following days: July 12 and 13th. They will arrive at 10:00am on the 12th and leave by 9:00am on the 13th.

Approximately 500 people will be camping overnight in the Meadows with tents and a shower truck. The showers will be located next to the maintenance building so that the water will go directly into the sanitary sewer. A fee of \$250.00 will be charged. Parking tags will be needed for 15 vehicles

Motion made by VanPatten, seconded by Myslinski to approve the Park Use application contingent upon the following:

- Police approval for wine and cheese served if on village property.
- Receipt of insurance
- Receipt of 250.00 fee.
- Vending permits needed if selling items or services.

- Summer jobs available in the Park to be posted on the website must be approved by the Mayor
- The Mayor met with CDTC and Schenectady County Economic Planning and Development to renew the linkage study. A suggestion was made for a memorial park which would link the Village to the Town of Glenville.
- The Board of Trustees discussed parking issues at the park and suggested a blacktop path between the beach parking lot and Rotary Circle/Kiddie Park.
- A grant was submitted for the walkway and equipment including a leaf sweeper, mower and utility trailer.

4. **Chairman's Report**

The Friends of Flint House are working on getting an arrowhead collection, formerly the property of Charles Moehle, to be housed at the Flint House.

5. **Supervisor's Report**

6. **Freedom Park**

There are some very exciting bands coming this year the list will be available soon.
