METROPLEX REVIEW

Ray Gillen, Chariman of the Schenectady County Metroplex Development Authority and Bob Diederich, member of the Metroplex Board present at meeting.

Gillen provided an overview of various projects that Metroplex has been involved in such as clean up at the GSA Navy Depot, development at Glenville Technology Park, Business Park development at Schenectady County Airport. In addition Gillen highlighted projects within the Village of Scotia that Metroplex has assisted in including demolition of 302 Mohawk Avenue, façade improvements at Scotia Cinema, Turf Tavern and Rolling Greens. Metroplex also administers the County Land Bank. Gillen stated that Metroplex works with property owners to leverage money to get a get return on investment. Metroplex works mostly with private sector to create jobs and increase the tax base rather than projects for public safety.

OVERVIEW OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

a) Food Truck Law

Mayor stated that if a food truck were to stay at a certain location instead of come and go each day, it would require a change of use for that property. This legislation allows food trucks without having to go through that process as long it meets the zoning requirements.

b) Water & Sewer Late Fee Law

Mayor stated that the proposed legislation clarifies the wording for the structure of late fees that are applied to water and sewer bills.

TOWN/VILLAGE COMMITTEE APPOINTMENT

Mayor will contact Supervisor Koetzle regarding expanding the committee to include more residents. Trustee Mathes and Trustee Tiberio suggested using the mass email to look for potential candidates.

- Development
